Board President Brian Little called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.


VOTE: Kuenning, yes; Shelby, yes; Valentine, yes; Dammeyer, yes; Little, yes 24-15

Mr. Valentine expressed that he was “caught and doesn’t want to vote against it, but he hasn’t had enough information to vote for it”.
