Welcome Back!

Below are some important points that will assist you through these first three days. Then, on Monday, August 25 you will receive a complete Student Handbook with detailed information about code of conduct and other relevant school information.

- Our Four Expectations**
1. Be positive with your words and actions.
 2. Be where you are supposed to be at all times.
 3. Respect other people's space and belongings.
 4. Be prepared for class.

Following Directions Each and every staff member will be treated with respect. If a staff member who you know or do not know approaches you, you will follow his/her reasonable direction. This applies in class and out of class, including the bus and anytime you are on school property or at a school event.

Dress Code The following are guidelines that generally apply to all students. Final determination as to the appropriateness of your clothing choices for school will be made by the Principal. Shorts must at least reach the end of your fingertips when your arms are extended, skirts/skorts must be at least three inches below your fingertips when your arms are extended. Shirts must be tucked into or overlap with your pants or skirt, have a neckline that is no more than two inches below the neck, not reveal armpits, and have at least inch wide shoulder straps. Undergarments are not to be seen when standing still, sitting, bending or raising your arms. Holes in pants must be small and/or below short level. Continually adjusting clothing to meet the dress code for a short time throughout the day is not compliance. If in doubt about an outfit, bring a change of clothing.

Electronic Devices Cell phones, iPods, MP3 players, radios, PSPs, portable CD/DVD players, etc... are to be off and in your locker during the school day.

Food and Drink Plain bottled water is allowed in the classroom as long as you are responsible with it. Gum is not permitted at school during the school day unless permission is granted by the principal.

Attendance If you are absent from school, bring a note signed by your parent or doctor the day that you return to school and turn it in to the office as soon as you get to school.

Tardy If you are tardy to school, bring a note signed by your parent or doctor when you return and turn it in to the office.

Lunch There are three lunch lines available each day: 1) The Pony Express. This is the traditional lunch line. 2) The Chuck Wagon. This line allows you to be creative. 3) The Corner Café. This line has salads each day. See the back of this paper for each menu. Know your pin number to punch in the keypad before you go to lunch.
