## SPECIAL SESSION

The St. Marys City Board of Education met for a special session in the auditorium at the St. Marys Memorial High School with the following Board Members present: Brian Little, Ronda Shelby, Karl Dammeyer, Travis Kuenning and Bob Valentine. The Board of Education special meeting was videotaped by Allen West of Digital Velocity Media.

Board President Brian Little called the meeting to order at 4:32 PM.

At this time, Board President Brian little read the following written statement:

I do not believe that Ronda Shelby, Karl Dammeyer or Travis Kuenning support the controversial statements Board Member Bob Valentine posted on a local social media website this past week. I want to take this time to remind all Board Members that their actions, their written words, and their verbal interactions are in no way private as an elected official. Mr. Brown issued a statement about this incident. The statements were insensitive and inconsistent with what this school district stands for. This incident has been unfortunate, but this Board intends on moving forward with more pressing concerns that we need to focus our time and efforts on.


