### SPECIAL MEETING

The St. Marys City Board of Education met for a special session at the St. Marys Memorial High School with the following Board Members present: Brian Little, Karl Dammeyer, Travis Kuenning and Bob Valentine. Ronda Shelby was absent. Meredith from The Evening Leader was also present.

Board President Brian Little called the meeting to order at 8:00 AM.

The tour began at 8:04 AM in the high school. MHS principal Bill Ruane led the group touring several classrooms and all the common areas (those shared by both the high school and middle school).

The next leg of our journey was led by Mary Miller, Middle School Principal. Mary showed us several classrooms. Particular attention was paid to those classrooms where the staff had requested the purchase of document cameras.

Meredith exited the group following the tour of the middle school.

The remainder of the group went out to the turf field site to review the current parking area. A request had been made to expand the current parking area. Upon completion, the group visited the maintenance building. The purpose was to review the storage limitations.

The next destination was the Denning Building where each of department head took time to explain to the BOE about the individual programs.



In addition, the concept of a shelter house and the planting of some shade trees were discussed.

Next we traveled to the Intermediate Building. Lisa Elson, Intermediate School Principal was our tour guide. We visited a few classrooms, but focused much of our tour in the gym.

Our final destination was the District Service Center where Dan Grothouse, Director of Transportation stated his desire to purchase 2 new buses, and MPV and an undercarriage wash system.
