## REGULAR SESSION

The St. Marys City Board of Education met in regular session in the auditorium at the St. Marys Memorial High School with the following Board Members present: Brian Little, Ronda Shelby, Karl Dammeyer, Chris Falk and Ron Wilker. Also present were reporters from The Evening Leader and The Daily Standard. The Board of Education meeting was videotaped by St. Marys City School's staff.

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 P.M. by Chris Falk, Board President, who then led the audience with the Pledge of Allegiance.
